

Working with Couples

Workshop in Christchurch with Walter Logeman

Friday 21 and Saturday 22 March, 2025

This workshop is for health professionals to build on the work you already do and to gain confidence and competence with family systems and couples. You will be invited to identify your strengths and build on them to enhance your practice.

We use psychodramatic methods and principles to raise awareness of family systems and to discover our learning questions. Then we *learn together* in action. We create a role play, literally an intergenerational drama to where we practice and witness the impact of our interventions.

We will focus on the most significant relationships in the system. This may take the form of therapy with a couple and possibly individual work with one partner in a relationship.
